MINUTES FOR BOARD OF ALDERMEN MEETING FEBRUARY 9, 2016 6:00 PM

The following elected officials were present: Mayor Coleman, Alderman Cearley, Alderman Huggins, Alderwoman Morrow, Alderwoman Thomas, and Alderman Withers.

The following staff members were present: Jim Palenick, Interim Town Manager; Maria Stroupe, Administrative Services Director; Town Attorney, Tom Hunn; Gary Buckner, Police Chief; Doug Huffman, Electric Director; Bill Trudnak, Public Works Director; and Steve Lambert, Fire Chief. Anne Martin, Recreation Director and Jack Kiser, Development Services Director, were absent.

Mayor Coleman called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

Mayor Coleman opened with the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Mayor Coleman asked if there were any additions or deletions to the agenda. Mayor Coleman stated there would be a Closed Session added to discuss Personnel. Alderman Withers made a motion to approve the agenda, including the added Closed Session, seconded by Alderwoman Thomas. Alderman Cearley stated that a correction needed to be made to the January 12th minutes where the vote was not listed after the motion and second naming Alderman Withers as the Mayor Pro-Tem. The motion to approve the minutes was approved unanimously, including the correction.

Alderman Withers made a motion to approve the minutes from the January 12th Regular Meeting, the January 21st Special Meeting, and the January 30th Budget Work Session; seconded by Alderman Thomas, and carried unanimously.

Consent Agenda:

Item 5A was a request to approve the uncollectable accounts for February in the amount of \$20,471.51.

Alderwoman Thomas made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda, seconded by Alderman Cearley, and approved unanimously.

Recognition of Citizens:

Mr. Robert Kendrick, 408 S. Groves St., stated that someone should look into the speakers in the Community Room. He said on many occasions it is difficult to hear the Board members comments.

Mr. Curtis Wilson, 438 S. Gaston St., prayed for our country, Town Leaders, Town Staff, the agenda, and the meeting. Mr. Wilson also stated that since he built his house five years ago, he has used a whole house filter on his water line. Normally, it would be tainted within a week of changing it. He last changed this filter around Christmas. Upon inspection within the last week, it is still white. He appreciates all of the work done to upgrade the water lines and the water plant. The results have been a great improvement. Mr. Wilson also thanked Mr. Palenick for all he has brought to the Town of Dallas. Mr. Palenick has brought abilities and talents that he has not seen anyone else bring. Mr. Palenick was also able to obtain grants and resources for the Town. Mr. Wilson believes the quality of life is so much better in Dallas than it used to be, since Mr. Palenick has been the Manager. Mr. Wilson stated that he wished the region had connected with Mr. Palenick to the point that he would be staying. He wished Mr. Palenick all the best in his new position in Fayetteville.

Employee Recognition:

Mayor Coleman informed the Board and audience that Janice Green, Public Works Administrative Assistant; achieved 20 years of service on January 26, 2016. Employees are now receiving appreciation gifts appropriate to their service anniversaries and will be publicly recognized at the Employee Christmas Luncheon.

Special Events & Requests for In-Kind Services:

Item 8A was a request to approve the Annual Kelly Guffey Memorial Run on Saturday, March 19, 2016. The race will begin at 8:00 am. (Exhibit A) The course will follow the approximate same route as previous years and will start at Main and Maple Streets. By approving the event, approval is given to close sections of several affected streets along the route for short periods of time as the runners pass through. The entire event lasts approximately 2 hours, with final cleanup wrapped up by noon. Alderman Cearley made a motion to approve the Kelly Guffey Memorial Run as presented, seconded by Alderman Withers, and carried unanimously.

Item 8B was request from the Sons of Confederate Veterans to hold their annual memorial service on the Courthouse grounds on Saturday, May 7, 2016. (Exhibit B) Jim Lowery, Commander of the Col. William A. Stowe Camp 2142 of the Sons of Confederate Veterans has stated no Town support services are requested or required. The service will begin at 2:00 pm and is expected to last approximately one hour. Alderman Huggins made a motion to approve the Sons of Confederate Veterans Memorial Service as presented contingent upon the Courthouse grounds being available, seconded by Alderwoman Morrow, and carried unanimously.

New Business:

Item 11A was a request to approve a contract with Lowdermilk Church & Co. for auditing services for FY2015-16 Audit. For the past two years; Lowdermilk, Church, & Co. have conducted the annual audits for the Town of Dallas. Based on the proposed contract, they will audit all Town financial statements and disclosures, for all funds, for the fiscal year July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016. They agree to complete the work for \$17,600 for the audit; \$3800 for preparation of the annual financial statements; and \$2700 for year-end book-keeping assistance; for a combined total of \$24,100. This compares to last year's combined total of \$23,400 (a \$700 or 3.0% increase) and compares to the final year (FY 2013) with Collis and Associates at \$26,500. The State Local Government Commission of the State Treasurer's office requires that local governments approve an audit contract before submitting it to their office for final approval. Alderwoman Thomas made a motion to approve the contract with Lowdermilk Church & Co. for the FY2015-16 audit as presented, seconded by Alderwoman Morrow, and carried unanimously.

Item 11B was a request to approve a series of budget amendments to the FY2015-16 Budget as follows:

- Amend the Fire Department Budget to reflect the receipt of \$2500 in Wal-Mart Foundation grant funds for fire prevention materials. (Exhibit C)
- Amend the Police Department Budget to reflect the receipt of \$2500 in Wal-Mart Foundation grant funds for equipment related to in-car computer installation. (Exhibit D)
- Amend the Administration Budget to reflect the need to add \$3440 for codifying the Zoning Ordinance. (Exhibit E)

Alderwoman Thomas made a motion to approve the budget amendments as presented, seconded by Alderman Withers, and carried unanimously.

Manager's Report

Mr. Palenick gave an update on various Town projects. Mr. Palenick thanked the Board for the opportunity to work in Dallas. He also thanked the staff and recognized their dedication to the community. Mayor Coleman wished Mr. Palenick well in this new position and thanked him for his time and accomplishments in Dallas. Alderwoman Thomas added her thanks, as well.

Closed Session:

Alderwoman Thomas made a motion to enter into a public hearing, as provided for by G.S. §143-318.11 to discuss a personnel matter; seconded by Alderman Withers, and carried unanimously. (6:27) Alderman Huggins made a motion to exit the public hearing, seconded by Alderwoman Thomas, and carried unanimously. (7:36) Alderwoman Morrow made a motion to pay Mr. Palenick three weeks of salary, seconded by Alderwoman Thomas, and carried unanimously.

Alderwoman Morrow made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Alderman Withers, and carried unanimously. (7:38)

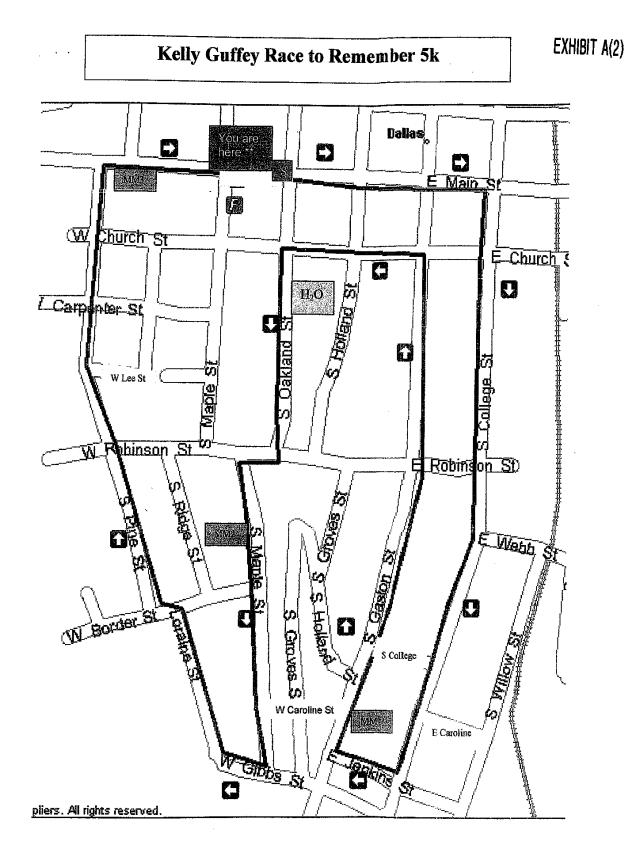

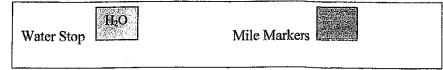
