Parking Lot Project – The project is continuing to progress. We can now park in the parking lot. The stamped concrete is being finished. The fencing has been ordered. From the last advertisement, we were not able to fill the position left open by Sam Martin. This week, a new advertisement has been placed in the newspaper. Also, we are sending the position information to Caldwell Community College, as they have a Lineman Development Certification Program. Hopefully, we will have these positions filled soon.

Town Events – Carols on the Square is tonight at 6:30 pm. The Dallas Christmas Parade will be next Friday, December 9th at 4:00 pm beginning at Ingles and traveling down Main Street, as per the usual route.
