BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen for the Town of Dallas that the following anticipated revenues and departmental expenditures are hereby appropriated and approved for the operation of the Town of Dallas and its activities for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2016, and ending June 30, 2017.

#### SECTION 5. LEVY OF TAXES

There is hereby levied, for Fiscal Year 2016-2017, an Ad Valorem Tax Rate of \$0.40 on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) valuation of taxable property as listed for taxes as of January 1, 2016, for the purpose of raising the revenue from current year property taxes, as set forth in the foregoing estimates of General Fund revenues, and in order to finance the foregoing applicable General Fund appropriations.

There is also hereby levied, for Fiscal Year 2015-2016, a Vehicle Tax of \$5.00 per year upon any vehicle resident in the Town of Dallas.

The Gaston County Tax Collector is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to proceed to collect taxes levied upon all real and personal property within the limits of the Town of Dallas based upon foregoing rates and, on all taxes upon which cost, interest or penalties accrue, according to law, the same shall be added and collected.

#### **SECTION 8. FEES SCHEDULE**

The Board of Aldermen shall adopt a schedule of fees and rates for various services, as may be amended from time to time as determined appropriate, to provide funding to cover costs for the provision of designated services.

#### SECTION 9. SPECIAL AUTHORIZATION - BUDGET OFFICER

The Budget Officer shall be authorized to reallocate appropriations within departments and among the various line items not organized by departments as deemed necessary.

The Budget Officer shall be authorized to execute interdepartmental transfers, within the same fund, not to exceed ten percent (10%) of the appropriated monies for the department whose allocation is reduced. Notification of such transfers shall be made to the Board of Aldermen as its next regular meeting following the date of transfer.

# SECTION 10. UTILIZATION OF BUDGET ORDINANCE

This ordinance shall be the basis of the financial plan for the Town of Dallas during the 2016-2017 Fiscal Year. The Budget Officer shall administer the Budget and shall ensure that operating officials are provided guidance and sufficient details to implement their appropriate portion of the Budget.

The Finance Department shall establish and maintain all records in accordance with this Budget Ordinance and the appropriate Statutes of the State of North Carolina.
