Dallas Recreation Code of Conduct

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this Code of conduct:

1. **I will** remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, not adults.
2. **I will** insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
3. **I will** refrain from “**GRANDSTAND**” coaching my child or other players during games & practices.
4. **I (and my guest) will** be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or other sporting event.
5. **I (and my guest)** will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent such as harassing, taunting, and using profane language or gestures.
6. **I will** inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
7. **I will** familiarize myself with the rules of the game and the policies of the league.
8. **I will** demand that my child treat all other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect.
9. **I will** demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol, and I will refrain from their use at all recreational and leisure facilities. Furthermore I will not arrive to a recreational facility or event under the influence of drugs, tobacco, or alcohol.
10. **I will** emphasize skill and development and practices and how they benefit my child over winning. I will also deemphasize games and competition in the younger age groups.
11. **I will** respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss, or confront officials or coaches at any recreational facility.

If I fail to adhere to these guidelines I understand that I may be subject to disciplinary action that could include, but is not limited to the following:

- 1st offense: The Parent/Spectator/Coach/Player will be ejected and suspended from the recreational facility or event and not authorized to return for any reason until a **two game suspension** is served.
- 2nd offense: The Parent/Spectator/Coach/Player will be suspended for the rest of the season.
- Repeat offenders or The Parent/Spectator/Coach/Player who has more than 2 offenses in any case will be banned from participating in Town of Dallas Recreation programs or events.

WAIVER/RELEASE FOR COMMUNICABLE DISEASES INCLUDING COVID-19

ASSUMPTION OF RISK / WAIVER OF LIABILITY / INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

In consideration of being allowed to participate on behalf of The Town of Dallas athletic program and related events and activities, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates, and agrees that:

1. Participation includes possible exposure to and illness from infectious diseases including but not limited to MRSA, influenza, and COVID-19. While particular rules and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious illness and death does exist; and,
2. I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or others, and assume full responsibility for my participation; and,
3. I willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for participation as regards protection against infectious diseases. If, however, I observe and any unusual or significant hazard during my presence or participation, I will remove myself from participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest official immediately; and,
4. I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS The Town of Dallas, their officers, officials, agents, and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event (“RELEASEES”), WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL ILLNESS, DISABILITY, DEATH, or loss or damage to person or property, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

I HAVE READ THIS RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND SIGN IF FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT.
